Please note: The checking process is only to ensure we have the correct events entered for an athlete. **No change to events can be accepted.**

Note: Inclusion in the listing of entries does not confirm entry into the championship for those athletes/families that are still trying to meet participation and/or duty roster eligibility requirements.

Eligibility for Centre Championships & Participation Awards - It is Centre policy that to be eligible for Centre Championships or end of season awards - including participation awards - athletes must have competed in more than 50% of regular KLAC competitions. It is pleasing to note that a large majority of athletes have already met the eligibility criteria. With only today's competition left we hope many more athletes also become eligible. Tim Golder & Warren Hosking Handicaps

In the past two seasons we have run the Tim Golder 100m & Warren Hosking 800m handicaps. The naming of the handicaps are after two ex-Centre Presidents who are long standing administrators of the club and both are still actively involved behind the scenes. Tim & Warren have made significant contributions to making our Centre as great as it is today. It is pleasing to report that a large number of athletes expressed interest in competing in the 100m handicap (open to U7-16s); and a healthy number have put their hand up to be part of the 800m handicap (open to U9-16s).

Handicap selection guidelines are included in the centre handbook but in general, automatic selection goes to athletes who have the best performance in their age group for the handicap distance or to the winner of 100m/800m in each age at the Centre championships. In addition, and so every athlete has a chance to participate in the handicaps, some spots are reserved for athletes for athletes who are randomly drawn out of the hat. The random draw will occur at the Centre Championships and all selected athletes will be advised on that day.

The handicaps will be held on Presentation Day, Saturday 27th March. Athletes involved will need to be in full KLAC competition uniform, including chest patch.
